

Mini Timmaraju

Mini Timmaraju is the Vice President of Public Affairs and Government Relations for Planned Parenthood of Houston, Southeast Texas and Louisiana. She is responsible for oversight of the organization's public affairs programs, policy initiatives, legislative agenda, and serves as the political director for the Planned Parenthood of Houston and Southeast Texas Action Fund, a 501(c)(4) organization and its affiliated political action committees. In these roles she has led the organization's outreach and lobby efforts for increased family planning funding, comprehensive sex education, and helped elect pro-choice candidates to the Texas legislature and to Harris County and the City of Houston.

Prior to her work with Planned Parenthood, Ms. Timmaraju was the District Director for the office of Congressman Nick Lampson (TX-22). There she managed the Congressman's constituent services and political outreach and served as an advisor on matters affecting Texas and the District. Prior to joining the Congressman's office, she served as a political and fundraising consultant for numerous state and local elected officials, candidates, non-profit organizations, as well as an ethnic outreach consultant for various corporations and government entities in Texas. She has also worked for Democratic candidates and campaigns in South Carolina, New Hampshire, Tennessee, and Oklahoma.

Ms. Timmaraju received her Bachelor's degree at the University of California-Berkeley and completed her J.D. at the University of Houston Law Center. She is the former president of the Asian American Democrats of Texas, a member of the State Democratic Executive Committee for the Texas Democratic Party, where she serves as the chair of the Majority Builders Committee, and a member of the Board of Directors of the Indo-American PAC of Greater Houston.
